JUSTIN HEINZEN **HEAD COACH / CAMP DIRECTOR**

Justin Heinzen is in his 13th season as head women's basketball coach at Loras

College. Heinzen, the program's all-time wins leader, has compiled an overall coaching record of 222-124, which includes three NCAA Tournament appearances in the last six seasons.

In 2018-19, the Duhawks had an all-time best 22-6 record and secured the program's first at large bid to the NCAA Tournament. Along the way, the Duhawks shattered 18 school records and finished in the top 25 in the nation in 3 point % (7th), Field Goal % (8th), Scoring Offense (15th), Free Throw Percentage (17th), Total Points (21st), and Assists (25th).

Heinzen has coached 27 players to all-conference honors, including 15 First Team selections. In the last 12 seasons, no women's basketball team has been more represented on the conference All-Academic team than the Duhawks, who've totaled 61 selections.

Heinzen graduated from Wisconsin Lutheran in 2004 with a bachelor's degree in American history and a minor in political science. Today, the Manitowoć, Wis. native resides in Dubuque with his wife, Kristina, daughter, Paityn, and son, Brayden.

BRIT KENT ASSISTANT COACH

Kent is in her fourth season as the primary assistant at her alma mater. During her time at Loras, Kent was an All-Conference selection and appeared in 106 games, averaging 7.4 points per game and was a 39.5 percent shooter from the floor. Following her playing career, Kent was a volunteer assistant for Justin Heinzen during the 2013-14 season in which Loras won the IIAC Regular Season Championship and Tournament Championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Kent currently resides in Dubuque.
